Sudden Cardiac Arrest is the leading cause of death for student athletes. While our district doesn't endorse specific testing, we do feel it is important to make it available if you choose. On Saturday, December 14, 2019 and Wednesday, January 15th, ATS HeartCheck will be returning to Shawnee Mission School District to provide their comprehensive heart assessments. This program is the national leader in youth heart screenings operated by highly trained medical professionals and overseen by pediatric cardiologists. Through special arrangements, the HeartCheck is being offered to all kids ages 8 to 25 for the special price of only \$129, normally \$1500.

The deadline to nominate a candidate is December 19.

Nominees must have completed at least five years in the profession and have served at least three years in the Shawnee Mission School District. The Kansas Teacher of the Year program recognizes teaching excellence across the state. The Kansas State Department of Education asks each school district to nominate one elementary and one secondary classroom teacher for the program. The person named Kansas Teacher of the Year is entered in the National Teacher of the Year competition and honorees are invited to become a part of a Kansas teachers network to share best practices and ideas.
