## 2019-20 Enrollment Process Begins This Week

Seventh grade students will have an enrollment presentation tomorrow (January 8) and eighth grade students will have their first high school enrollment presentation on Friday, January 11. This will be an opportunity for students to here a focused presentation about course options available to them. Eighth grade parents and students are encouraged to attend the open house event on Wednesday of next week (Northern Exposure) in preparation for high school counselors to return on Friday, January 18 to pick up enrollment cards. Northern Exposure begins with optional activities from 5:25-5:55 pm. These include visiting with the high school counselors in the main entrance (Times Square) or Special Education in Room 125. At 6:00, everyone will convene in the auditorium for opening ceremonies, a message from SM North Principal Dr. Higgins, and instructions for the evening. Rotation activities include athletics/activities, core classes, electives, and signature programs. We hope 8<sup>th</sup> grade families are making plans to attend this important evening.

## Signature Program Open House

The Shawnee Mission School District invites middle and high school students and their families to the annual Signature Program Open House, to be held from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Tuesday, January 15, at the Center for Academic Achievement, 8200 W. 71st Street.

Those attending the open house will visit state-of-the-art classrooms and labs, speak with instructors and current students, and learn about options for creating flexibility in their high school schedules to allow time for enrollment in coursework.
